Terms & Condition:-

1. The tender documents submitted should be computer typed. In "Technical bid" if any cutting is made that should bear initial of the authorized signatory. Over writing in any paper will render that document invalid. In "Financial Bid" cutting as not allowed.
2. The tenderer should have minimum three yrs. experience in supplying drugs & medical consumables to the Government / PSU hospitals as a manufacturer or sole marketer or authorized distributor or authorized dealer.
3. The bidder shall have to submit EMD of Rs.100000/-(Rs. one lac) only in the form of Demand draft / FDR/ Bank guarantee from a schedule bank drawn in favor of Superintendent VIMS Hospital, pawapuri, payable at pawapuri. Those who claim to be a small scale industry unit will have to submit registration with small scale industries deptt. as well as update unit running certificate from appropriate authority. They are exempted from EMD. However if they become the successful bidder then they have to deposit this amount in the form of DD / FDR / Bank guarantee as performance Security Deposit. EMD Demand draft and tender document fee drafts shall be attached with Technical Bid.
4. The tenderer shall have to submit VAT Registration certificate, PAN Card, Service Tax Registration and update service tax deposition certificate.
5. The tenderer shall have to submit update drug license (Manufacturing / sale) with product approval. If it is not manufacturer then valid updated authorization letter/letters of manufacturer / manufacturers of the items being quoted for supply. If the tenderer is manufacturer it shall highlight those products whose rates have been quoted in financial bid but rates must not be mentioned. If rate mentioned found in Technical Bid the Bid of the particular agency will be rejected.
6. Valid update GMP Certificate clearly indicating the products (items) issued by centre / State Drug controller. If manufacturing firm has applied for revalidation of GMP. Then certificate from State Drug Controller that the firm has applied for GMP certificate revalidation.
7. Tenderer shall submit Market standing certificate / Physical existence certificate issued by the Drug licensing authority of the respective State / District that the quoted product is manufactured / marketed by them since last three yrs.
8. Tenderer shall submit affidavit regarding not being blacklisted by any Government agency. Likewise this type of affidavit also has to be given by the manufacturer that its proprietor/partner/Director or the Agency has not been blacklisted and the product the rate of which has been quoted also not been declared substandard by any Government Institution. It will also sworn in the affidavit that during the currency of contract if the firm (manufacturer/supplier) or its product which is ordered/supplied is/blacklisted/banned/found substandard it will inform to the authority regarding this within fifteen days.
9. The "Technical Bid" will be analyzed and "Financial Bid" of only those firms who are found eligible in Technical Bid will be opened in due course and the eligible firms would be intimated there of accordingly.
10. The tender fee is non-refundable. The EMD of the unsuccessful bidder in "Technical Bid" shall be returned without interest after finalization of contract. EMD of successful bidder/bidders will be converted into performance security deposit. If small scale Industry firm becomes successful bidder it also has to submit now performance security deposit of Rs. 100000/-(Rs. One lac)only in the form of demand draft/FDR/Bank guarantee in favor of Superintendent, VIMS Hospital, Pawapuri, Payable at Pawapuri.
11. Tenderer shall submit affidavit to the effect that no case is pending against it/manufacturer/proprietor/partner/Director before police/any court of law and if it happens in currency of contract it will be informed within fifteen days to the authority.
12. Price quoted by the tenderer shall not in any case exceed the control price fixed by NPPA/central/State Govt. and preferably should be at least 20% less than the market price. If more than one agencies rate is found L1 superintendent reserves the right of award contract to one or may split the order to companies of L1 rate. If L1 agency does not comply

the order supply within stipulated time the order will go to the L2 and the difference amount will be recovered from the performance security of the L1.

13. Those bidders who intent to supply products of more than one manufacturer, they have to highlight the name of the manufacturer in the front of the product which they will supply. Once the company and its particular product is approved in no case that will be changed and the supplier will have to supply the product of the same company approved by purchase committee.
14. Each and every page of both Technical & Financial bid must be signed by the authorized signatory. Documents should be legible and page numbered.
15. Products strip must super scribed name, strength of drug, manufacturer name, batch no., month & year of manufacture, month & year of expiry if the product is a mixture of two or more than two molecules then strength of each molecule as per Drug & cosmetic Act 1940 and rules. Injectable drugs should be super scribed route of administration i.e. IM/IV/SC/Intra dermal (ID).
16. The composition and strength of each item tendered should be as per specification given. All oral liquid preparation shall be supplied in non breakable plastic containers as per standard laid down in I.P. 96. The tenderer quoting for oral liquid preparations will have to give an undertaking that the plastic container are made from materials confirming the IP specifications standard and a copy of the test report of the plastic container used by them are from an approved laboratory under the Drug & Cosmetic Acts and rules there under. If any of the item(oral liquid preparation) in the Tender is not permitted to be supplied in non-breakable plastic container as per IP the same item can be packed in virgin glass bottle as per IP.
17. The analytic report of the item has to be submitted with the supply of the product. Drug sampling will also be done from time to time by drug inspectors for quality test. In case the quality of goods supplied are not in conformity with the standard or the supplies are found defective at any stage appropriate action such as imposition of penalty, cancellation of agreement blacklisting, lawful action will be taken against defaulter supplier / manufacturer as decided by the purchase committee.
18. If at any time during the period of contract, the price of tendered items is reduced or brought down by any law or act of the Central or State Govt. or by the tenderer himself, the tenderer shall be morally and statutorily bound to inform VIMS immediately about such reduction in the contracted prices. Purchase committee is empowered to unilaterally effect such reductions as is necessary in rates in case the tenderer fails to notify or fails to agree for such reduction. In case of any enhancement in Excise Duty / Custom Duty due to statutory Act of Govt. after the submission of the tenders and during tender period, the additional Excise Duty / Custom Duty so levied will be allowed to be charged extra as separate item without any change in price structure of the drugs approved under the tender. In Excise Duty / Custom Duty, the tenderer should produce letter from the concerned excise authorities indicating his commitment for the supply made to VIMS, Pawapuri on account of the increase in Excise Duty / Custom Duty.
19. The supply should be within thirty days of supply order. The ordered items have to be delivered at store of VIMS Hospital, Pawapuri and no extra amount will be paid for this.
20. Purchase committee may cancel the order or allow extension of time applying the liquidated damage depending on the situation.
21. Drugs and Medical consumables delivered to VIMS Hospital, Pawapuri of delivery should have shelf life of at least 75% of the stipulated total shelf life from the date of manufacturing of that product.

22. Liquidated Damage:- All the good ordered shall be delivered within thirty(30) days from the date of issue of order. All the aspect of safe delivery to the store VIMS, Pawapuri shall be the exclusive responsibility of supplier. If the supplier fails to deliver the goods on or before the stipulated time, a penalty at the rate of 0.5% per week of the total order value shall be levied subject to a maximum of 10% of the total order.

23. Making:- Each packing should be marked with nomenclature of the drugs and shall be labeled in accordance with the requirement of the Drugs and Cosmetic Act. 1940 and the rules made there under.

24. Packing:-

1. All labels of cartons, ampoules, vials, bottle etc. should be emboldened / imprinted / stamped Bihar Govt. supply, not for sale.
2. Loose / tampered / damaged labeled supplies will not be accepted.
3. All the packing should be new and of such quality to prevent damage or deterioration of products during transit to final destination.
4. All containers i.e. bottle, tin, tubes etc. are required to be secured with pilfer proof seals to ensure genuineness of the products packed and the correctness of the contents.
5. All primary packing containers which come in contact with the drug content should strictly protect the quality & integrity of drugs and medical consumables.

25. Testing of Drugs-quality control:-

1. Regular and random testing of drugs will be undertaken from Govt. / Govt. approved laboratories at any time during the shelf life or whenever any defect is noticed.
2. The report of the Govt. / Govt. approved laboratories shall be accepted by the firm.
3. If any product / products are found to be Not of standard quality on test analysis tenderer will be liable for consignment against the particular invoice irrespective of the fact that part or whole of the supplied items may have been consumed.
4. Recovery of test costing will be as per rule.

26. Legal Jurisdiction: - All matters of jurisdiction shall be at the local court located at Biharsharif, Nalanda.

27. This Rate contract will be valid for financial yrs. 2016-17. However, if the system of State Procurement agency come in force and start supplying, this rate contract will automatically come to an end.

28. Rate contract of a particular drug will never mean that the order will be given. Order will be given as per need of the hospital.

29. Refund of EMD: - EMD without interest shall be returned to the unsuccessful bidders after completion of contract process papers will not be returned.

30. The tenderer will be bound by the details furnished by it in the tender. In case any such of documents furnished by it is found to be false at any stage, it would be deemed to be a breach of contract making it liable for legal action besides termination of contract.

31. The superintendent reserves the right to amend/add/delete/relax any condition of the tender document without any notice at any stage. He reserves the right of suspending/cancelling the whole tender process at any stage without assigning any cause.
